

The paper "Classroom Talk: Co-constructing a Difficult Student by Graff" is a marvelous example of an educational article review. Relationship between teacher and students during the learning process in the classroom is important to ensure that complete information is transmitted. The paper by Graff (2009) highlights the area where the research was carried out to understand the relationship between the complexities behavior of students and teacher through classroom discussion and the manifestation of the same. The analysis suggests that difficulty in relationship exist when the teacher interacts with a student during class discussions compared to one to one interactions. Graff (2009) further states that in order to reduce the complexities in behavior a more structured classroom environment will help to improve the relationship and facilitate the learning process. Yabon (2010) on the other hand states that mediation helps to develop teacher and students relationship. For classroom learning, I feel that developing a teacher and student relationship is a must. According to the study by Yabon (2010), I feel that mediation helps in case of verbal and physical assaults and helps to develop a relationship to a certain extent. However, the study from Yabon (2010) pointed out that having mediation helps to build a healthy relationship even in the classroom setting.
